This course will deepen your grasp on the often-elusive quest for human happiness. The readings will be two contemporary books available to you for free. The first book provides the up-to-date scientific research on what makes individuals happy. The second book addresses a global perspective on happiness, including a qualitative comparison of happiness levels in different



countries, with many nations consistently scoring higher than the United States. The critical question that this course will answer is: How can we be happy and what might Brazilians know about it that we (as Americans) may not (yet)?
