

Exam #3: Study Guide

The final exam in this course will take place during final exam week on April 27th (see syllabus for time) in our usual classroom. The exam will consist of 60 multiple choice questions. Of these, 20 questions will be taken directly from exams #1 and #2. The 40 new questions will focus both on the assigned readings (Myers' Exploring Psychology chapters 11, 14, 15 and the online readings) and on the lectures & discussions held during class time. As always, there will be a few questions taken directly from each of the online quizzes (chapters 11, 14, 15). Below is an outline of the major topics that the new material on the exam will cover to refer to as a guide in deciding where to concentrate your attention while studying.
