

How I Made My Fraction Pieces

I used graph paper that is 5 squares per inch. The graph paper is for sizing only. The paper used for the actual fraction pieces should be plain white, and should be thicker than regular paper, but not as thick as index cards. Each fraction piece is labeled with a black marker (but not a thick marker). The pieces are then covered with contact paper.

The one whole piece is 24 by 24 squares.

The one-half is 12 by 24 squares.

The one-third is 8 by 24 squares.

The one-fourth is 12 by 12 squares.

The one-sixth is 8 by 12 squares.

The one-eighth is 6 by 12 squares.

The one-ninth is 8 by 8 squares.

The one-twelfth is 4 by 12 squares.

The one-sixteenth is 6 by 6 squares.

The one-eighteenth is 4 by 8 squares.

The one-twenty fourth is 4 by 6 squares.

The one-thirty sixth is 4 by 4 squares.
